























Britain took control of Palestine from the Ottoman Empire during the first World War, declaring that it could be used to establish a Jewish homeland. Although the historic 'Balfour declaration' contained assurances regarding the rights of those already living there, a memorandum in 1919 exposed the extent of the British operationals.

'In Palestine we do not propose even to go through the form of consulting the wishes of the present inhabitants of the country... Zionism be it right or wrong is more important than the wishes of 700,000 Arabs."
